COVID-19 Education



In early September, President Joe Biden announced his COVID-19 Action Plan which included mandating vaccines for companies with more than 100 workers and companies that work closely with federal contracts. However, this mandate isn't so simple. While we investigate the language in the mandate, we highly recommend you get your vaccine now. If a specific requirement comes from the federal government stating IFB has to mandate vaccines, the decision will no longer be for IFB Solutions to make, and rather something that we will be forced to implement. Remember: the last day to submit proof of vaccination to staysafe@ifbsolutions.org is Oct 17th if you would like to be entered into a drawing for a chance to win \$500.



Flu Shots Available

Our medical teams are prepared to administer flu shots at all manufacturing locations. Members of Blue Cross Blue Shield can get a shot with no-copay if you are <u>not</u> receiving other services from your physician. A copy of the consent form can be obtained from your supervisor. Please make an appointment with your local medical staff and bring this form filled out. In Winston-Salem on Wednesday and Thursday, October 13th and 14th, the medical team will be visiting workstations in manufacturing to administer shots.
