UPDATE: COVID Vaccination Mandate

The Occupational Safety and Health
Administration's (OSHA) rule that requires
employees at companies that have more
than 100 workers be vaccinated is back on.
This rule had been blocked in November, but
a Circuit Court of Appeals made the decision
Friday evening to lift the block (or "stay")
that effects more than 84 million workers in
the U.S., including all of us at IFB Solutions.

The new vaccination deadline for IFB Solutions employees is February 9th.

This decision comes as the Omicron variant has been found in every state in the U.S. but six. If you want to know which vaccine is right for you visit the CDC's website, or click HERE.

Mobile Mammogram Makes Way to Winston-Salem

Wednesday, January 12, 2021

Location: Employee's parking area.

- Please wear a mask. All patients will have their temperature taken and will be asked pre-screening health questions before beginning the exam.
- Mobile and equipment will be disinfected after each patient.
- If the patient has had a previous exam outside of Novant Health, the patient will need to provide that information to the technologists at check-in.
- The patient will need to bring her insurance card and driver's license or picture ID on the date-of-service.
- Must have an active primary care provider (Doctor, Physician Assistant, Nurse Practitioner, etc.).
- The mobile is for screening patients only. If the patient has a problem with her breast (pain, lump, six-month follow-up, etc.), she will need to be seen at the Breast Clinic.
- The mobile technologists will obtain each patient's demographics when they come for their mammogram.
- A Novant Health Breast Center team member will call the patient after their exam to go over the Risk Assessment information.
- Those employees interested should inform their supervisor no later than Wednesday, December 23, 2021.
