#### **CLVC** Item of the Week:

Titanium Telescopic Cane - \$54.95. Titanium telescoping cane expands from 9 sections and automatically locks at each section for lightweight, durable usage. Cane won't inadvertently collapse when in use if pushed too hard. Single push button action collapses the entire cane. Shaft is metal colored; bottom of the cane is red. Luminous graphene reflective material coats each joint and allows for better reflectiveness in the dark. Lighter in weight than regular mobility canes. Collapsed cane measures 11.5" long. Fixed metal tip has a 0.8" diameter. Includes an elastic wrist strap.

#### **Mobile Mammogram Makes Way to Winston-Salem**

Mobile Mammography will be held on Wednesday, January 12, 2021 in the employees parking area.

Please wear a mask. All patients will have their temperature taken and will be asked pre-screening health questions before beginning the exam.

Mobile and equipment will be disinfected after each patient.

If the patient has had a previous exam outside of Novant Health, the patient will need to provide that information to the technologists at check-in.

The patient will need to bring her insurance card and driver's license or picture ID on the date-of-service.

Must have an active primary care provider (Doctor, Physician Assistant, Nurse Practitioner, etc.).

The mobile is for screening patients only. If the patient has a problem with her breast (pain, lump, six-month follow-up, etc.), she will need to be seen at the Breast Clinic.

The mobile technologists will obtain each patient's demographics when they come for their mammogram.

A Novant Health Breast Center team member will call the patient after their exam to go over the Risk Assessment information.

Those employees interested should inform their supervisor no later than Wednesday, December 23, 2021.
